



CY2007-2008 High Comp Fees



The information below is being provided as a means to effectively communicate and manage training / coaching costs during the CY2007-2008 season. In addition to training-only services, the High Comp Program offers a Paid Coach Plan which provides all technical direction for the team throughout the playing season.

The playing season is defined as beginning the week after school gets out (mid June) and ending at the conclusion of District, Association, or State Cup play (as appropriate). This system is in use in many surrounding leagues and is viewed by most as the next logical step in the development of competitive soccer in Livermore. It is also a means by which a team without benefit of a volunteer coach can participate in the High Comp Program.

Please note that under Training Fees the *Approx. Player Costs* are based on 12 player rosters for U9-U10 and 16 players for U11-U19. Actual player costs will vary depending upon the number of players rostered on any given team and the total number of months a team decides to train. All teams are required to train a minimum of 5 months. These fees must be paid in advance and are not refundable.

Total program costs are obtained by adding the *High Comp Fee (\$184)* to the *Approx. Player Costs*. Please keep in mind that there are additional expenses for such things as uniforms, tournament entry, etc. that are not reflected in this document.
