KICKING OFF THE SOCCER SEASON WITH REGISTRATION WEEKEND

Livermore Youth Soccer League is ready to sign up all interested youth soccer players.

February 6, 2006, Livermore, CA – Registration for the 2006 youth soccer season is kicking off with an in-person registration event on February 18-19, 2006. Any youths ages 4-18 that are interested in playing this year should attend this registration at Livermore High School's Student Union. The event will be open to take registrations from 9am-5pm on both days.

House uniforms will be available for purchase at the in-person event, as will soccer cleats and other soccer related items. These will require separate checks from registration payment. House uniforms may also be ordered through our website.

Online registration will also be an option this year. An announcement will be made on the league's website as soon as the site is operational. This service will provide our members with an option to skip the in-person event and sign up at their convenience by computer. An additional benefit to online registration is that registration fees could be paid by credit card; an option not previously available.

“We are excited to enter into our 28th year as both a combined boys' and girls' league,” said Corey Nelson, league President. “Troy Dayak will be continuing as our league's Technical Director for both the High Comp and Recreational playing programs. Having this professional ex-player and Olympian working with the league has brought a great deal of excitement to our kids and parents. A true strength for the league is its volunteers and of course the kids.
